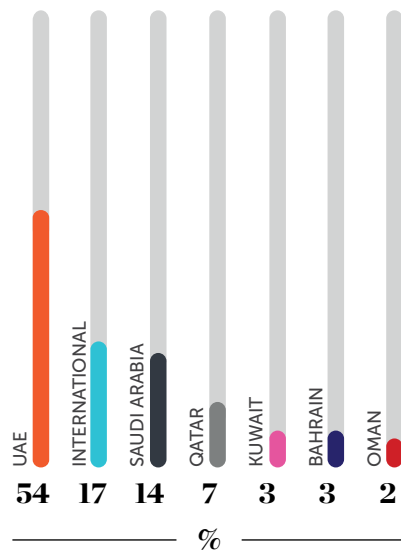

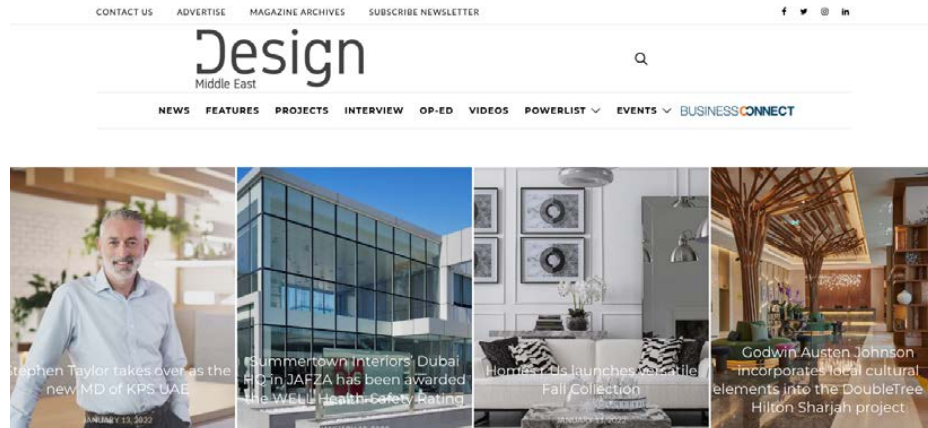

Material may also be submitted for Macintosh in Adobe InDesign CS5 or below, Adobe Illustrator CS or Adobe Photoshop CS formats. All scans, logos, illustrations and fonts (used in the layout document and placed EPS files) must be supplied in addition to the layout file. We do not accept Microsoft Word, PageMaker or Publisher files. If a PDF cannot be produced, files from PC computers must be saved to an EPS format, with all fonts outlined and either all images embedded or supplied separately. Conversion charges may apply.

COLOUR

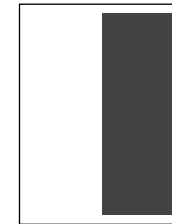
